

Carolina Senior Softball League (CSSL) – The “Saturday” League – Age 55 and above

The Carolina Senior Softball League is made up of teams within an approximate 100 mile radius of Charlotte. It was formed to provide tournament-like playing opportunities without the time and financial commitment demanded by traditional tournament ball. Depending on field availability and the number of teams expressing interest this year’s CSSL should be similar to 2009. If there are multiple Charlotte teams in the league the coaches of the teams will have the sole responsibility for their respective teams. The Charlotte teams will need to commit and pay in advance, just like the other teams. When you register please indicate whether or not you’re interested in the CSSL. (Playing Preference question #1).

Home-Home Series – Age Is Dependent on Competition, Usually 60+

These reciprocal events, though quite similar to those of the CSSL, are primarily arranged with teams located further from Charlotte than the typical CSSL team. Three opponents have already been identified – Sun City-Bluffton SC, Seneca, SC, and Tri-Cities, TN. Sometimes these events may involve a one-night stay (Sun City, Johnson City) and occasionally are played on weekdays (Seneca). Teams participating in these events have the most flexible rosters. However, if we have an established team of players in the proper age group I’ll generally call on them for these events. If you play on one of the CSSL or tournament teams I’ll automatically have you on the list. If you’re not playing in the CSSL or on a tournament team but are interested in participating in these events let me know so I can add you to a list of potential players. (Playing Preference question #2)

Traveling Tournament Teams – Age 50 and above

These teams require the most time and financial commitment of all opportunities. Teams are formed by age group (50’s, 55’s, 60’s, 65’s, and 70’s). Off-season discussions indicate there may be a number of Charlotte-based teams – Carolina Curve (50’s), Lou’s Royals (55’s) and maybe another one or two. When you register please indicate whether or not you’re interested in a traveling tournament team and I’ll put you in touch with a coach. (Playing Preference question #3).

Mecklenburg County and North Carolina Senior Games – Age 55 and above

As in past years Mecklenburg County would like to see participation in the Games. It’s an easy event to arrange if any of the established age-specific teams (CSSL or travel) wish to participate. If a “new” team must be formed solely for this event the task becomes more troublesome. Be aware that separate registration forms and fees for Mecklenburg County and North Carolina must be completed with firm deadlines. As you register, please let me know if you’re interested in participating. (Playing Preference question #4). I’ll be glad to provide a list of interested players to anyone who would like to form a team.

Other Local Leagues – Not age specific

These are always an alternative, individually or as a team, and are often expensive, unless you have a sponsor, and competition can sometimes be 20-30 years our junior. ASA, Interlink, Sports Connection and church leagues offer some alternatives. Several of you are already associated with teams playing in other leagues. I hope you'll have time to fit Charlotte Senior Sports in your schedule.
